Ron Manfield recently produced "50 Years - the NORMAN AMADIO trio", one of three albums recorded by Norman Amadio, one of Canada's premiere musicians, at the Glenn Gould Studio CBC Toronto.

As a singer/pianist, Ron performs to appeal to mature, sensitive listeners. Exceptionally well-received by delighted audiences, they are warmed to his performances when he combines his mellow voice with unique piano stylings. His albums include: Dreams of Christmas and A Man, A Concert and His Music on Manfield's music label MPC Music. The label also handles the distribution for Guitarisma featuring Bobby Edwards.

In 1989 A Man, A Concert and His Music took place at the Premiere Danse Theatre in Toronto. Ron Manfield composed, performed with his 34 piece orchestra with his musical director Bobby Edwards as conductor/arranger. A CD release and a DVD is available on line at www.mpcmusic.com

Ron made his first professional appearance at the age of seven, playing piano on CKVL Radio in Quebec. Born and raised in Verdun, Quebec, he began writing at ten, studied music in Montreal and turned professional in his early teens. It was then that Ron went to New York City to continue to realize his creativity and established a sense of commitment to the music industry. Maintaining a personal approach to his work, both as a writer and a performer, he has played his versatile repertoire on the piano lounge circuit across Canada and the South Western United States. Along the way, he met prominent artists who provide him with his sense of dedication and direction.

Booby Edwards started playing the guitar at the five years of age.

He was born into a very musical family and was blessed with his father's encouragement. His musical influences started with Country Music (the late Chet Atkins), and Elvis Presley.

Bobby landed his first weekly TV series on CBC at sixteen. This was a teen rock show. By the time he was 18, he was recognized as one of Canada's most successful recording studio guitarists. Here are just a few of Bobby's accomplishments:

Five years with Kenny Rogers. Also guitarist for Paul Anka, Anne Murray, Henry Mancini, Ella Fitzgerald and Oscar Peterson.

For the past number of years, Bobby has been a first call guitarist for Toronto's heavy theatre scene. In addition to playing guitar, Bobby hold credits as conductor, arranger and composer for films, stints at the Las Vegas Hilton and two performances for Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II.
